## DROP OFF YOUR LUGGAGE AT THE VILLA-DES-PRÈS HOTEL

Nestled in the heart of Saint-Germain-des-Près, where fashion and culture converge, Villa-des-Près is the perfect intimate retreat for lovers of the capital. The charm of the VIth arrondissement operates at 29 Rue de Buci, where Villa-des-Près settled in a chic and discreet private mansion that opened last spring 2023.

In a vibrant and historical area, this spot provides an excellent opportunity to explore the Left Bank between the Seine River and the Luxembourg Gardens. You'll find a mix of art galleries, bookshops, art-house cinemas, and renowned Parisian fashion brands in this dynamic neighbourhood.

When it comes to the architecture, the beautifully renovated Haussmannian-style front of the building instantly sets the tone with its carefully crafted cut stones, multi-floor balconies, and decorative elements, creating a welcoming atmosphere. Villa-des-Près is a finished architectural project resulting from detailed craftsmanship, emphasising the importance of art in various forms. The 34 rooms, including 14 suites and shared spaces, blend tailor-made furniture with artistic creations. Amélie du Chalard from Amélie Maison d'Art collaborated with five artists to bring nearly fifty unique pieces to decorate the hotel's walls. Bruno Borrione, a French interior architect, supervised the interior design, artistic direction, and the creation of custom furniture. Working with French artisans, he contributed
